Summer greetings for the 2017 season from the Mountainview Woodies of Maine.

I would like to thank everyone for making last years show a very successful one. The weather cooperated, we had a large group of spectators and a good number of exhibitors with boats in the water or on trailers. We also had a number of old cars present. This year's show is on August 12th with the rain day of August 13th. Exhibitors should arrive to tie up or set up between 8am and 9:45am. The show opens at 10am to the public. I would also like to thank those people who responded to our call to help us at the boat show last year. We couldn't have done it without your help. We will again need people to help us sell clothing and raffle tickets again this year. Please give me a call at 207-925-3142 if you are interested in helping.

Last year The Freedom Cafe allowed us overnight docking on Friday night for our show participants and spill over docking the next day for the Boat Show if needed. They have been very generous in allowing us to use the docks again this year. Also last year Freedom Cafe catered our Friday evening dinner, it was a great success. The dinner will be set up as a Buffet again this year. We will be eating outside on the lawn by the water and if the weather doesn't cooperate, they will have a tent set up for us. The Buffet will again feature Chicken Marsala, Beef Tips and a Fish dish. The meal will be served with a Caesar salad, vegetables, rolls, butter and a dessert. Price for the Buffet is \$26.00 per person. Everyone will be responsible for their own beverages.

Last year we had dinner on Friday at 5pm and the Arrival Parade at 7pm on Brandy Pond. Switching the two events turned out to be a huge success. We had an announcer introducing boats as they motored past the town docks. There were a large number of spectators lined up along the Causeway and under the bridge as you come out of the channel from Brady Pond even with the constant threat of rain that evening.

Long Lake Marina was generous in letting us use their launching ramp last year. They said that

they are very happy to have us come back to launch at the marina again this year and also said that we can use their storage facility up behind the Naples Town office to park trailers. Moose Landing is under new ownership and has extended an invitation for us to use their launching ramp for the show again this year. I would like to thank both Marinas for their generosity in letting us use their launch ramps.

The Show format this year will be the following: Camp Sunshine rides will be on Tuesday August 8th on Sebago Lake at 1pm. Wednesday August 9th at 10am, we will leave Naples for a cruise up Long Lake to Harrison for a fun lunch at the Tie Up store. Everyone can order off the menu and we can eat on their tables at the water front. The Migis/Sebago Run is on Thursday, August 10th at 1pm. Friday evening, August 11th will be our Buffet dinner at the Freedom Cafe starting at 5pm then followed by the Arrival Parade starting at 7pm on Brandy Pond. Saturday, August 12th is Show day from 10am to 3pm. Posters and Ships Store items will be available at the Show. Sunday, August 13th will be the rain date.

We had our 10th Fall Foliage Cruise up Long Lake to Harrison for lunch at the Old Mill Restaurant. We had a nice turn out with nice weather on the way up to Harrison. The Lake on the way back became very rough with a steady south westerly. A couple of us had wet ride home. We will post the dates and times for this year's Fall foliage Cruise on the web site.
